### ***Commissioner Note:***

We are happy to announce that Tenali Municipality ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> place in performance Indicators for the month of November – 2016 among 110 ULBs all over the state of Andhra Pradesh. Also stood at 5<sup>th</sup> place in overall cumulative ranking for the year 2016-17.

During the month of November Municipality is implementing schemes for development of the town. We are implementing the state and central government schemes such as Implementation of Go-No 279 on Solid Waste Management, Smart Pulse Survey, and Amrut. Smart Pulse Survey was launched on July 8<sup>th</sup> across Andhra Pradesh with an objective to ascertain the socio-economic status of people and 96% of the households have been surveyed in the Tenali Municipality by the end of November 2016. Feasibility surveys have conducted for construction of STP's in the town under AMRUT. Now a days technology is playing key role in day to day life. Our Prime Minister already launched digital India campaign and our Chief Minister is always step ahead in adopting technology. In order to provide realtime governance Andhra Pradesh government is gradually shifting from traditional administration to electronic administration in all departments. Recently Municipal Administration department has started using e-Office in all the municipalities and Municipal Corporations. We have also launched this initiative.

## Current activities

### Council Meeting:

The council meeting organized in the starting of the month. The Meeting focussed on, allocation of municipal funds, Implementation of Go-No -279 on Solid Waste Management, developments of roads and other development works also granted funds for this purpose. After various discussion except 26 agendas all other agendas has been accepted by the council.



### SMART PULSE SURVEY

The Smart Pulse Survey launched on July 8th across Andhra Pradesh with an objective to ascertain the socio-economic status of people. As a part of it Hon'ble MLA launched Smart Pulse Survey at Tenali Municipality along with Commissioner. As many as 96 enumerators were conducting survey covering all 40 wards in the town. On this occasion Hon'ble MLA Sri. Alapati Rajendra Prasad visited wards personally and stated that people should co-operate to enumerators and register their details in the survey. Almost 95% of the households have been surveyed in the Tenali Municipality by the end of November 2016.

## Implementation of Go-279 on Solid Waste Management

Go No-279 of solid waste management initiates the effective handling of the solid waste and sanitary cleaning activities in the City. It provides a strategic framework and operational details for systematic handling of all the related activities in the solid waste management and sanitation services of the City Administration.

### The main objectives are:

1. Guiding the ULBs for effective implementation of MSW rules, NGT directives and other relevant regulations in a systematic manner, with reference to Source Segregation, Collection, and Transportation of Solid Waste.
2. Guidelines for micro planning of the residential, commercial areas and main roads, work responsibilities, and methods for carrying out the sanitation and solid waste management activities.
3. Rationalizing the norms for manpower, transportation of vehicles, tools, implements and conservancy materials.
4. Guiding the ULBs on the methods of tendering and contract management aspects.

In November 2016, Municipal Administration department has organized a worked to provide technical sanction to all the municipalities and municipal corporations. Tenali

municipality has successfully obtained the technical sanction on 28-11-2016 for two packages including commercial with an estimate of 10.38 Crs and 8.01 Crs for the period of three years.

## E-Administration

Government of Andhra Pradesh has introduced and mandated e-Office in the Municipal administration. Commissioner has arranged training one-Office with the help of Urban Development Research team. Urban Development Research team conducted one day training all municipal administration and supported in practical training. Municipality has started e-Office after this training.



### **Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana - National Urban Livelihoods Mission (NULM):**

The mission would aim at providing shelters equipped with essential services to the urban homeless in a phased manner. In addition, the mission would also address livelihood concerns of the urban street vendors by facilitating access to suitable spaces, institutional credit, social security and skills to the urban street vendors for accessing emerging market opportunities.

In this scenario, Tenali Municipality has taken initiative to identify street vendors and suggest policy changes to improve the present situation. The supreme court itself commented to treat them as a part of our geevana vidhanamu. And as directed by the State to bring a policy to identify street vendors which deals with the welfare and regulations. Tenali Municipality has been divided into three categories: Vending Zone, Partially Vending Zone, and No Vending Zone. Tenali Municipality has provided them identity cards and loans with subsidised interest and covering with insurance. Our Hon'ble MLA Sri Alapati Rajendra Prasad Garu has distributed identity cards and has granted loans to Street vendors on 7th November, 2016.



### **Swachh Sarvekshan Activities -2017**

In order to foster a healthy competition between cities, the Ministry of Urban Development (MoUD) started the “Swachh Sarvekshan” survey in 2016 which rated 73 cities across the country. Following the same, the MoUD has issued guidelines for “Swachh Sarvekshan” 2017 which will conduct a survey to rank 500 cities (having a population of 1 lakh and above).

The components covered in this survey are:

- Solid Waste Management (SWM) including road sweeping, municipal solid waste from residential, commercial areas and from construction & demolition waste.

- Individual, community and public toilets
- Open defecation free city/town strategy
- Information, education and behaviour change communication (IEBC) strategy, and
- ICT based system to enhance Urban Local Body (ULB) operations.
